1. Each Sculpture, any medium and suitable for outdoors display, the subject of which will be the inspiration gained from Coonawarra, must be the work of the competitor. Artworks must have name, address, title and price clearly written with the Sculpture.
2. Artworks should be left or consigned to Balnaves of Coonawarra, Riddoch Highway, Coonawarra SA 5263 by Friday 11 May 2012. No payments whatsoever will be made by the Coonawarra Vignerons Association for freight or other charges incurred in the delivery of any entry. A fee of \$20 per entry must be paid or lodged with the entry form by Friday 11 May 2012, any cheques/money orders/cash to the Coonawarra Vignerons Association.
3. The Coonawarra Vignerons Association reserves the right to refuse to display any entry without being required to give any reason. The Coonawarra Vignerons Association reserves the right to exhibit for a period of up to fourteen days any entry submitted for competitions.
4. The Coonawarra Vignerons Association will exercise all reasonable care with exhibits submitted but will not accept responsibility for loss or damage while they are in its custody. Packing should be labelled and suitable for return and artists are expected to pay all charges incurred in sending and returning works. Artworks are to be collected on Monday 28 May 2012 between 9am - 3pm.
5. THE WINNING SCULPTURE ENTRY WILL BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE COONAWARRA VIGNERONS ASSOCIATION.
6. The **announcement of the winner** of the prize will be made at Balnaves of Coonawarra, Riddoch Highway, Coonawarra on Saturday 19 May 2012 at 3pm. All competitors are invited to be present.
7. 25% Commission + GST will be charged on any work sold.
8. MAXIMUM SIZE OF ART WORKS 2.00 metres high x 1.00 metre wide (oversize sculptures not eligible for judging).
9. ENTRIES CLOSE FRIDAY, 11TH MAY 2012.
